Credit mobility

Credit mobility for universities

- International strand to fund 135,000 scholarships for mobility to / from partner countries including ACP countries
- Short-term studies (3-12 months) abroad that count to a degree back home
- At bachelor, master and doctoral level...
- ...and for staff (5 days – 2 months)
- HEIs from Programme countries apply to their National Agency on behalf of all their partners

Credit mobility scholarships

- If your university has an Erasmus+ agreement with a European university, you may be able to receive a grant for mobility
- First agreements with ACP universities are being signed over the summer
- Grant covers travel to Europe, living costs
- Fees are waived
- Contact your university's international relations office

Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees for universities

- Excellent integrated Master courses offered by consortia of 3+ HEIs from Programme (and Partner) Countries
- Attract best students worldwide through EU-funded scholarships
- 12 – 24 month courses with study in 2+ countries; joint or multiple degrees
- Programme-Country institutions may submit a proposal on behalf of an international consortium



Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree scholarships

Masters consortia select students

- Check the list of Master courses
- Apply directly to the course
- Apply in autumn 2016 for programmes starting in September 2017
- Each course offers 15-20 scholarships per year
- Around 150 courses to choose from:

- Focus on European integration studies
- Teaching and research (Modules, Chairs, Centres of Excellence)
- Policy debate with academic world (Networks, Projects)
- Support to activities of institutions or associations

Youth



Youth Capacity Building

- » Foster youth cooperation between Programme countries and Partner Countries from different regions of the world;
- » Improve the quality and recognition of youth work, non-formal learning and volunteering in Partner countries and enhance their synergies and complementarities with the other education systems;
- » Test and launch schemes of non-formal learning mobility at regional level ...
- » Promote transnational non-formal learning mobility, notably targeting young people with fewer opportunities:

Duration of the project: between 9 months and 2 years

Age: no limitation/number of participants: max 50
